### RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Society adheres to a Non-Selective program which requires that all FIRST FRESHENER animals on the farm be presented for classification. At the option of the herd owner, any unclassified animals in 2<sup>nd</sup> or later lactation may be presented for classification and any previously classified animal may be presented for a possible raise in classification.

When applying for classification, herd owners are subject to all existing rules and regulations of the Canadian Goat Society, which govern this program.
