

DELIVERY & PICK-UP: Meters, sample vials and other supplies can be picked up from your nearest Lactanet staff. We can provide a drop-off and pick-up service at an additional charge based upon total km driven (see pricing worksheet on back).

SAMPLING: A sample from each cow is obtained using a meter with a sampler or from a bucket milker. For mechanical meters, mix milk from the meter by pouring milk from flask back and forth from a pitcher three times. Mix milk from a bucket by pouring back and forth from one pail to another two times. If you sample one milking, fill the vial to the line. If you use two milkings, fill the vial 1/3 each milking. We DO NOT recommend the use of a 'strip' sample except for pregnancy testing.

ENSURING SAMPLE QUALITY: Check all vials to make sure each vial has a preservative pill. If missing, use a pill from one of the extra empty vials. Once milk is collected, gently invert all sample vials several times to ensure the preservative pill is dissolved. DO NOT SHAKE. Store samples in a dry, cool area until shipped. Avoid excessive heat and freezing.



RECORDING YOUR COW ID

- Ignore the printed barcode and number on the label. Strike through barcode and number on the label with a thick black or blue marker.
- Using a ball-point pen, write only the cow number (do not use letters) on the remaining white space of the label. Please take care to write legibly.
- Do not write cow names on the label. If cow name is the primary ID in your herd, or if you are submitting quarter samples, mark the labels from 1 to xxx (as many cows/quarters as you sample) and keep a reference worksheet of which number corresponds to which cow name or quarter.
- All test results will be returned by the number you write on the label.
